A contraction is a shortened way to say two words. The first word stays the same. The second word gets a letter or letters taken out and replaced by an apostrophe (').

A possessive shows belonging. For words that are singular (one) or don't end in an s, you add an apostrophe and then an s ('s). For words that are plurals (more than one) or end in an s, you add an apostrophe after the s (s').
