The following pages make up the "Tower Template" for the two-dimensional version of The "Tower of Books" Challenge. The Tower Template is where the child pastes each cut-out-book. The template has all the book-outlines in order, forming a place to create the tower of books.

The 40-book tower template is seven sheets long. Each page gets connected vertically to the page beneath it, forming a very tall template. The size is a motivator! The child can hang it on the fridge (or wall) for continuous display, or roll it up like a scroll when not in use.

Note: If the child is doing the 30-book or 20-book option instead of the 40-book option, use the corresponding "cap-page" (the template sheet at the top of the tower) to "cap off" the tower at the appropriate number of books. The 30-book and 20-book cap pages are found at the end.

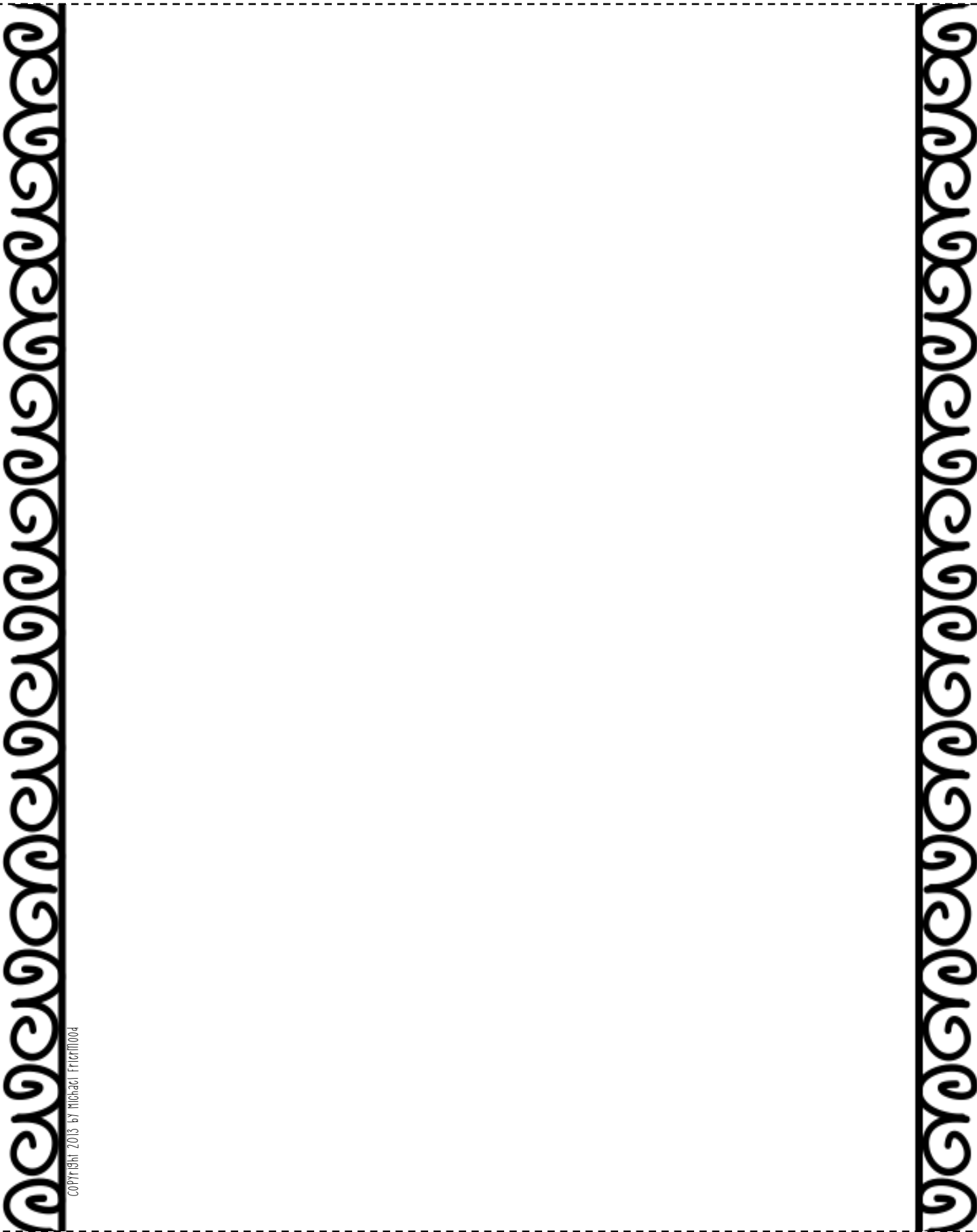
