

The following pages are the cut-out-books for the three-dimensional version of The "Tower of Books" Challenge. Each time a child reads a text from the category list, she cuts out one of these books, fills out the title, category, description, and personal rating (by shading 1-4 hearts). Then she folds along the dotted lines, creating a rectangular prism resembling a book. The tabs get tucked, and then the edges get taped (or glued using the tabs). The child uses her 3D cut-out-books to begin forming a stack.


Every book read means a taller tower of books! She can save a special spot at home (or school) to keep the tower and watch it grow, or rebuild the tower as often she wants! (From experience, a single stack of the 3D cut-out-books gets unstable at around 20 books high, so look for creative ways to build the tower with more than one stack.) Check the "Guide" file for step-by-step photographic instructions! Every 10th book is red. These are good opportunities to build-in intermediate incentives.


